
SUBJECT: Army Installations Symposium and Exhibition, 4-6 April

At your request the Office of General Counsel, Department of the Army and the Office of the Secretary of the Army have reviewed the material on the subject event with the Office of DoD General Counsel.

That office has concluded that the Association of the United States Army's (AUSA's) administration of the symposium—including its collection of registration fees as the principal sponsor of this event—and the Army's support of the symposium are consistent with applicable federal appropriations law and regulation. Accordingly, the Army may participate in this event as authorized under section 3-211 of the Joint Ethics Regulation.

This determination should not be considered HQDA endorsement of the meeting nor approval for widespread attendance.

Any approval for attendance, including standards of conduct regulations, must come from the local Army Commander or staff element leadership. Additionally, future meetings must be structured in such a way as to be in compliance with all HQDA, OSD and other federal guidance and regulations.
